

"INDOOR GOLF" RULES

A GAME OF GOLF DICE

Every Roll plays a hole—18 rolls—18 holes—Par 72.

The Five dice are rolled at one time.

The colours in sequence—Red, White, Blue, Yellow and Green determine shot from tee to green.

Read the dice in above order counting each dice a shot *Unless* penalty or extra shots are designated on dice—until the dice shows you are "on the green" then putts are added for total score on the hole.

Obviously, if the third or fourth shot shows "holed out" the score for hole is determined as no putts are necessary.

If the first (red) or second (white) shows "on the green" putts *must* be added for score on hole even though the yellow or blue may show "holed out."

Par on each hole is FOUR. The lowest possible score is TWO (drive on green and one putt). The highest possible score is NINE.

"Indoor Golf" can be played match (by hole) or medal (by 18 hole score) with competitive interest the same as regular golf—TWO BALL—FOUR BALL and SUNNINGDALE etc.

"19th Hole Golf" is the original, championship GOLF-DICE game; selected as a tournament golf-favor: at the PGA Seniors, the Ryder Cup, the Dinah Shore LPGA, the Johnny Miller Classic, and many other major tour events.

"19th Hole Golf" is an authentic game of golf played with dice. Each roll of the dice plays a hole. All of the dice are rolled at once. You can play medal play (the player with the fewest total number of strokes at the end of play) or match play contests (the player who wins the most holes). You can play team against team, with 1 point scored for the low ball and 1 point for the team with low total. Any number of players can play "19th Hole Golf."

Read the dice as follows: RED-WHITE-BLUE-BROWN-GREEN. Read the dice in order, counting a stroke for each of the dice read. Penalty or extra shots are indicated on the dice. OB - Out of Bounds.

IT MAY NOT BE NECESSARY TO READ ALL OF THE DICE.

When the dice you are reading (in order) red, or white, or blue reads "on the green," regardless of which dice it is, you go right to the GREEN putting dice, and add the number of putts to complete the hole. EXAMPLE: If the first (red) or second (white) reads "on the green," putts are then added, even though the blue or brown indicate "holed out."

★ The lowest possible score is 1, the highest is 9.

★ **HOLE - IN - ONE** is scored when the solid dot appears face-up on all 5 dice. Odds: 7776-1.
