Four cards of the same name are called a set. The game consists in collecting the cards in sets. The set receives its name from the name at the top of the card. The card receives its name from the first branch of business.

INSTRUCTIONS:

Deal the cards one at a time, until each player has five cards. Place the remaining cards face down upon the table. The person at the left of the dealer then calls for any card of the set, of which he holds one or more cards, from any of the players, until he calls from some one who does not hold the card named.

The player who called then draws the top card from the pack on the table. If it is the card last called he continues. But if it is not the card named the one on the left then calls.

When the four cards are together they are laid aside and count one point in the game.

The extra card if placed with the set doubles the value of that set.

In calling a card select from one of the three names in small type and call the card, naming the set and the person from whom you call.

If during the game a player runs out of cards he may draw one so long as cards remain on table.

GRAIN DEALERS' EXCHANGE

Eight cards of same name are called a set. The game consists of collecting the cards in sets. There must be a player for each set used.

INSTRUCTIONS:

Deal the cards one at a time until each player has eight cards, except the one at the left of the dealer who has nine. Select the grain you want to corner. Put the grain on the market by offering to trade or exchange 1, 2 or 3 cards at a time. When you have collected eight cards of the same name, call out "Deal Closed." This stops all trading, and counts to the successful trader the price of the grain.

If a player collects 7 cards of the same grain and holds the "Market Cornered" card, he calls out "Closed" and it counts double the price of the grain.

If a player collects 8 cards of same grain and holds "Market Cornered" card, he calls out "Market Cornered," which counts double for the successful trader and bankrupts all other traders.

Do not be afraid to make a noise. Trade and trade fast.

When each trader has dealt the cards twice it constitutes a game. Each trader is credited with his earnings at the close of each game. The one who has the largest amount is dubbed "The Millionaire."
