HOUSEKEEPING

This game is not limited to any particular number of proper players.

Give five cards to each, dealing one at a time, and the remainder are placed, face down, in centre of table.

There are fifty cards, consisting of ten books of five

cards each.

Each book has its distinctive name, such as "Parlor Furniture," "Bedroom Furniture," "Diningroom Furniture," etc., and each book also has a value in "points," which is designated by the number at top of card.

The object of the game is to secure as many books as possible, those counting the greater number of points

naturally being in greater demand.

Upon each card, directly beneath the illustration, is printed in large type the name of the vehicle represented, and beneath this, in smaller type, appear the names of the

other four which make a complete book.

The first player to the left of the dealer starts the game by calling for some card that is needed for a book, one or more cards of which he holds. Player may ask for card from anyone. It is, of course, understood that card desired is that one bearing illustration and name in large type. Player does not lose his or her turn until card is saked for which is not held by player from whom it is requested. A card is then taken from the pile in centre of the table, and the next player to the left proceeds.

When all the cards in centre of table and players' which have been drawn the game is finished, and the one having the highest number of points (not books) wins. Should all the cards held by a player be called before his turn arrives, and there are no cards in centre of table, such player is privileged to call for a card from any other player, from memory, and proceed in usual manner.


