MATCH AND CATCH.

DIRECTIONS FOR PLAYING.

Any number can play. Choose one for the first player; the one chosen shall take all the cards, and having mixed them, hold them printed side down, and give to each player an equal number. He must then place one of his cards on the table printed side up. The player on his left then lays one of his cards on the table; if it is like the one first laid down, he *Matches* and *Catches*, and takes both, then puts the top card of those he held in his hand down for a leader. If it is not like the first, the next in turn plays, and so round and round, until one is laid having the same picture as the leader; when this is done, the player is said to *Match*, and, of course, *Catches* all on the table and takes them. The player who gets all the cards wins the game.
