

DIRECTIONS FOR PIXIE BOARD

PIXIE BOARD: An educational toy for children of from 4 to 8 years. Designed in the Toy and Game Research Laboratories of Cadaco-Ellis, it is ideal to amuse small children playing alone or with others.

OBJECT:

To match the Answer Blocks to pictures on the Picture Sheets. Children will in this way learn to recognize familiar objects and to read and spell the names of these objects. When all pictures are matched properly turn over the PIXIE BOARD . . . open, remove the Picture Sheet and . . . SURPRISE! If all pictures have been matched correctly . . . a complete picture will be found.

EQUIPMENT:

A Pixie Board.

Four series of Picture Sheets:

1. Birds and Animals.
2. Familiar Toys.
3. Familiar Foods.
4. Familiar objects around the Home.

Forty-eight Answer Blocks for each Picture Sheet.

METHOD OF PLAY:

1. Open the Pixie Board. Put a Picture Sheet face-up in the frame.
2. Break Answer Blocks apart, shuffle and place answer side up on the table. (Answer Blocks for each Series are the same color as the Picture Sheet, i.e., Blue, Pink, etc.)
3. Match Answer Blocks to pictures on the Pixie Board.
4. When a Picture Sheet has been completely filled in, close the Pixie Board and turn it over.
5. Now open the Pixie Board and remove the Picture Sheet.
6. Surprise! . . . If all pictures have been matched correctly a complete picture will be found.

NOTE: Many children are amused by putting the pictures together as Jigsaw puzzles.
