Story - Game - Puzzle

1. As a Story

Read the verses and look at the pictures.

2. As a Puzzle

Push out the cut-out pieces of each picture through the page and get them together in one place (a large envelope is good - or a small box). Then try to reassemble each animal.

You will make a lot of amusing mistakes before you put the animals together again.

3. As a Game

Pick out all the cut-outs belonging to one particular animal in the book. Then add to these cut-outs about five or six of the cut-outs which belong to the other animals (the more cut-out pieces you add, the harder the game). You are now ready to play a game with your friends. Each player gets four chances to complete the animal. The player who puts the animal together correctly in his four tries wins the game.
