

SPIN-- A-- Quiz

One player is appointed referee.

The referee spins the two spinners at the same time and calls aloud the category at which the one spinner stops, and the letter at which the other spinner stops.

All players, including the referee, now try to be first to call out an appropriate word fitting the category, and starting with the letter.

For example, if one spinner stops at "A Country" and the other stops at S somebody might call "Spain".

The first player to call the correct word receives one red token from the referee.

If none of the players can think of an appropriate word within a minute or two, referee may spin again without making an award for that spin.

Players may exchange five red tokens for one blue token. First player to win three blue tokens is the winner.
