Instructions for Playing the Cow & Gate
game of

"SNAP"

1. The game can be played by any number of persons.
2. The cards are dealt round until exhausted.
3. Each player places his cards on the table in front of him, face downwards (without having looked at his cards) and as his turn comes round turns up one card and places it before him face upwards.
4. When two cards of the same picture are turned up, the player who first calls "Snap" takes both cards and the cards covered by them. He places these beneath his main pack and commences again.
5. If two players call "Snap" together, and it cannot be decided who was first, the disputed cards are put face upwards into the pool in the centre of the table. If a card is turned up the same as the top one in the pool, the call is "Snap Pool."
6. Anyone who calls "Snap" in error is often penalised by having to put all his upturned cards in the pool.
7. When a player loses all his cards he is out of the game and the one who eventually holds all the cards is the winner.
