

GUESS GAME

(Pla-Board #603)

Directions for Playing

This is a two-board game, where each player has a Board of his own.

The player having the first turn writes a number from 1 to 8 in the lower lefthand corner of the board, being careful to cover up or hold his board so that his opponent cannot see what number he is writing. The opponent then guesses what number he wrote down. If he guesses correctly, (let's say it was number 7) he writes number "7" in one of the squares in the "7" column on his board. If he does not guess correctly, the player who wrote the number "7" writes it in one of the squares in the "7" column on his board and puts **another** number down for the other player to guess. The same player **keeps writing** numbers in the lower lefthand corner of his board until his opponent guesses correctly.

It is then the other player's turn to put a number down and have his opponent guess. The one who gets his board full first—four figure 4's in the four squares in the "4" column, seven figure 7's in the squares in the "7" column, etc., wins the game.

It is wise to start out by putting your large numbers down first because you have so many more of these squares to fill.

"IT KEEPS YOU GUESSING."

Better results will be obtained by sharpening your chalk either with a knife or pencil sharpener.

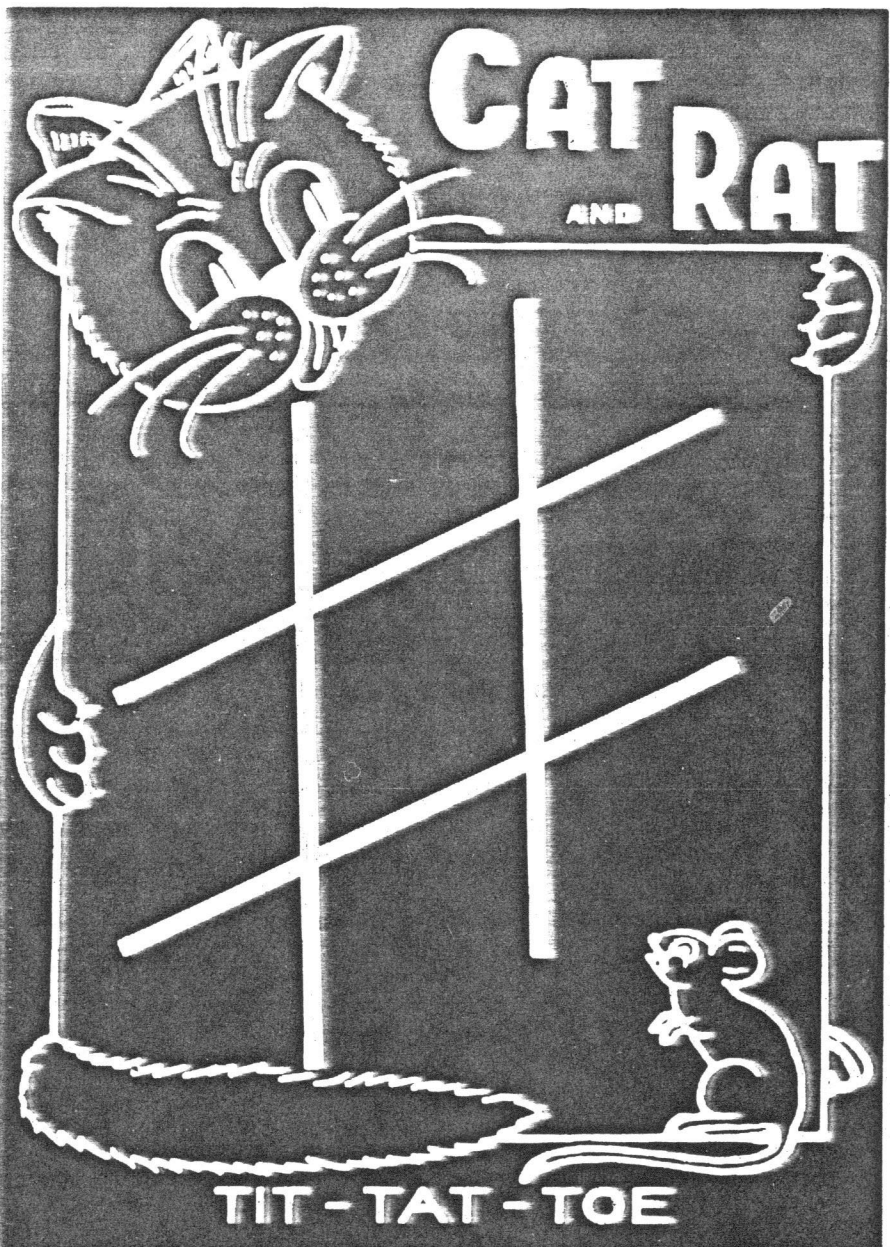
