

THE GAME OF  
GUESS AGAIN

HOW TO PLAY IT.

1. Do not read the cards but distribute 3 or 5 to each person in the circle, leaving the rest of the pack to be drawn from in turn by each player when he loses or lays by a card.

2. The one beginning the game reads aloud one of the guesses which he holds and calls upon the person at his left to answer. If the person called upon answers correctly (according to the answer which is on the same card with the guess,) he receives and lays aside the card as in his favor.

3. If the person called upon cannot answer, the player asking for the answer then calls upon the person at the left of the one first asked, and so on round the circle till the guess is guessed,—whoever guesses correctly receiving the card.

4. If no one can guess the conundrum, the player may announce the answer from the card, and lay it by in his own favor.

5. As the cards are graded, he wins the game whose cards amount to the largest sum.
