Pic is played by two people.
Place 15 marbles in the 15 holes on the outer circle of the board.

Then in alternate turns each player removes one, two or 3 marbles at each turn until the board is cleared. The one removing the last marble is the loser.

The object of the game is to make the other player remove the last marble, and as each player has their choice of removing one, two or 3 marbles, it is that one that removes all but the last one marble that wins.

T I K T A K T O E

Tik Tak Toe is played by two people on the center section of the board. Each player has 5 marbles of one color.

The object of the game is, placing one marble at a turn, to have three of the same color in a row, either vertically, horizontally or diagonally.

The player must block the opponent and, at the same time, try to place three of his own marbles in a row.

If neither wins, the game is considered a tie, and a new game is started. The players alternate placing the first marble.
