

Directions for Playing <sup>36</sup>**"COWBOYS & INDIANS"****CARD GAME**

*This deck contains an equal amount of Cowboy and Indian cards plus 4 "Tomahawk" and 4 "Six-Shooter" cards.*

**WHEN 2 PLAY**—Cards are mixed up thoroughly and then dealt out one at a time until the entire deck is divided equally between both players. Each player keeps his cards, in a pile, face down in front of him. The dealer is the first to go and turns up the top card of his pile, placing it face up on the table. As he does this, he calls out "Indian" or "Cowboy" depending on the picture. The other player does the same and in rotation each one turns up the top card from his pile until one turns up a Six-Shooter or Tomahawk. When a player turns up a Six-Shooter and his opponent has an Indian or Tomahawk showing he calls "Captured" and takes all of his opponents' turned-up cards and adds them to his own pile of open cards. Also the player who turns up a Tomahawk Card when his opponent has a Cowboy or Six-Shooter showing takes all of the other players' turned-up cards. When a player has exposed all of his cards he just turns his pile face down and the play continues until one player wins by capturing all the cards or all the Tomahawks and Six-Shooters.

**WHEN 3 OR MORE PLAY**—Cards are shuffled and dealt out until all are divided among the players. Each player places his cards in a pile, face down in front of him and the dealer is the first to go. He turns the top card face up in front of him and the player to his left then follows and does the same. If he's able to, he takes the bundle of the player next to him on his right. Then the next player to his left does likewise and the play continues in the same way around the table. As each player loses all — of his cards, he is eliminated from the game — or when a player loses all of his Six-Shooters and Tomahawks he is also eliminated and places his remaining cards in a discard pile. The player who succeeds in capturing all the cards or all the Tomahawks and Six-Shooters is the winner.
