There are thirteen books, four cards on the life of each boy in a book. The books are as follows: Abel, Joseph, Moses, Samuel, Jonathan, David, Uzziah, Josiah, Daniel, John, Jesus, Paul and Timothy. There are also two premium cards, the **STAR** and **CROWN**, and one forfeit card, **ABSALOM**. From two to six persons may play.

Shuffle the cards, distribute six to each player, leaving the remainder in a pack from which to draw. Begin by calling for a card to fill out a book, part of which the player must have. He plays till he does not receive the card called for and then draws from the pack. If the card so drawn be the one just called for, the player is allowed to go on calling till he missees. Then the play goes to the next one to the left. Whoever draws the **STAR** and any card on the life of Jesus, may claim the rest of the book. Whoever draws the **CROWN** and any card on the life of Josiah may claim the rest of the book. Should any player have the book of Jesus or Josiah, without the Star or Crown, he must call for the Star or Crown before the book is complete, but no one can call for the rest of the book if he has only the Star or Crown. Whoever draws the **ABSALOM** card first loses one turn. The card is put into the pack and when it is drawn again the player loses one turn. It is put again into the pack and when drawn the third time the player does not tell of it. He hopes to pass it on, when the pack is all drawn from the table and the players draw from each other instead of from the pack. The players may draw opposite to the way they take turns. The player who has the Absalom card at the close of the game forfeits one book to the one who has the most. He wins who has the highest number of books.

To make the game most profitable, parents should play with the children. After a few games, let some one choose a Bible boy for study. Look up in the Bible references give on No. 1 card. By reading the context, fuller instruction can be given by parents.
