

How to Play
BUCK ROGERS

Three to Six Players
Age Up to Nine

In this game there are a number of pairs of cards and one odd card, **KILLER KANE**.

The two cards of a pair have the same picture and same name.

Shuffle the cards and deal one at a time until they are all distributed.

Then all players pick up their hands and match as many pairs as possible laying these face up in the center of the table.

The dealer plays first by drawing one card from his right hand neighbor, and if possible, matches another pair. Then the player from whose hand the card has been drawn, in turn draws a card from player on his right, also trying to match another pair. Thus the play continues until all pairs have been matched.

After all pairs have been matched, the player having the odd card left in his hand is **KILLER KANE**.

For Older Players

The game is played exactly as above except that at the end of the game all players take their books (pairs) and calculate their score as follows:

BUCK ROGERS.....	25 points
WILMA DEERING.....	15 points
DR. HUER.....	15 points

All other books 5 points except the player having KILLER KANE is penalised 25 points and must deduct that from the score of his books. Player having highest score wins.
