

How to Play
OLD MAID

Three to Six Players

In this game there are a number of pairs of cards and one odd card, the OLD MAID.

The two cards of a pair have the same picture and are numbered alike.

Shuffle the cards and deal one at a time until they are all distributed.

Then all players pick up their hands and match as many pairs as possible laying these face up in the center of the table.

The dealer plays first by drawing one card from his right hand neighbor, and if possible, matches another pair. Then the player from whose hand the card has been drawn, in turn draws a card from player on his right, also trying to match another pair. Thus the play continues until all pairs have been matched.

After all pairs have been matched, the player having the odd card left in his hand is the OLD MAID.
