### Directions for the Game

1. Any number of persons can play this game.
  2. The dealer distributes one card at a time around the circle from the right to the left until all have three cards. He then places the pack face downward on the table. The answer to each question follows the question.
  3. The player at the left of the dealer begins. He asks B at his left hand any question from any card in his hand. If B can answer it he takes the card and turns it face down on the table. If B does not answer the question it goes around the circle to the left, until it is answered, or all have had a chance. The one who answers it gets the card. If nobody answers the question A keeps the card in his hand, and B takes his turn at asking.
  4. Now B asks C at his left hand the second question in the same way, and so on.
  5. When any player has asked a question and given up a card to the one who answered it, he must draw another from the top of the pack, so that each player holds two cards in his hands all the time. If any player finds that he has a card from which nobody can answer any question, he may keep the card and draw another.
  6. The one who gets the most cards wins the game.
  7. The game may be played in partnership by any even number of players. The partners sit opposite each other and keep their cards together.
  8. In a large company it may be necessary to vary the rules a little. A less number than three cards may be given to each player, if the company is so large that the pack does not go around.
- At school, a nice way is to choose sides the same as a spelling contest. Many other games may be played with the cards.
