## DIRECTIONS.

The object of the game is to reach the winning number 75. A

dice for throwing numbers from 1 to 6 may be used.

The game may be played by any number of players. Each player throws once and then follows the directions given in the verses attached to the number he throws. If no directions are given he waits at that number until his turn comes again. All subsequent throws are added to the number which you have thrown before. For instance, a player throws 5, he immediately moves to 20 and then waits until the others have played. Suppose he then throws 6, adding 6 to his former 20 he finds by the directions that he has advanced to 32, etc. Any person throwing 70 steps out of the game, having lost.

Any one throwing over 75 must go as many back again as is

over this number.

He who first reaches 75 has won the game and takes what is left in the bank.

This highly instructive and amusing game gives the player a complete narration of the principal facts of American history.

The directions for playing it have been put into the verses, found under each picture, in order that the attention may be constantly drawn to the facts connected with it. It is a game which should be introduced in every American family, especially for the children, as the study of history thus becomes a source of pleasure instead of an exertion.
