How To Play Ching Gong

- 1. Two or three may play, each selecting a color.
- 2. Each player has fifteen men. These are placed on the intersections (blue dots) in the nearest triangle of the corresponding color. All moves are to intersections also.
- 3. The object of the game is to be the first to get all your men into the opposite triangle bearing your color and in the same position as the set up.
- 4. You move one at a time, either to an adjacent uncovered dot or jumping over your own or another player's man. These moves or jumps are forward, sideways or backward on a straight line.

Jumping over one man at a time, you may continue jumping over as many men, including your own, as you have openings for at one play.

You jump to gain ground but do not remove any men at any time. Try to play your men so as to block the other players' moves.

- 5. You must not move your men into a section bearing a color other than your own.
