THE GAME
of
FLOWER LOTTO

An instructive and amusing pastime played on the same principle as Lotto. It teaches the children the correct names of garden flowers through play.

DIRECTIONS

The game of Flower Lotto consists of six beautifully printed cards in full color, each bearing eight pictures of different garden flowers. From two to six players can play the game.

Sitting around a table; the cards are evenly divided among the players. Then all the counters, which are duplicate pictures of the flowers on the cards, are put aside in a heap, face down, and one of the players is selected as the "caller." The "caller" takes from the heap, one counter at a time and calls out the number and name of the flower shown thereon. The players see if this flower appears on the card or cards before them. Whoever, luckily, has the picture on his card gets the counter, which is laid over the corresponding picture.

Whoever fills a card first, wins the game.
