DIRECTIONS

An amusing and instructive pastime played on the same principle as Lotto.

The game consists of six cards, each representing a room — kitchen, dining room, bedroom, etc. Each card shows a colorful picture of the room, and bears eight pictures of objects found in that room. The counters are duplicates of these pictured objects.

From two to six can play the game. The cards are evenly divided among the players, who sit around a table. Then all the counters are put aside, face down, and one player is selected as the "caller." The caller takes one counter at a time from the pile and calls out the number shown thereon. The players see if this number appears on the card or cards before them. Whoever has the picture on his card gets the counter, which is laid over the corresponding picture.

Whoever first furnishes his room by filling his card, wins the game.
