

MICKEY MOUSE

AGES 4 AND UP

Jigsaw fun with mounting excitement as you race to put all the parts of Mickey together.

THE GAME

There are four Mickey Mouse puzzles, in four different color outfits. Two to four players assemble their individual jigsaw pieces by matching the numbers on the exclusive "POP-O-MATIC". The first person to fit his or her puzzle together all in the same color wins.

BEFORE YOU PLAY

- 1. Remove puzzles from the box and carefully separate the pieces from the cardboard frame. Discard the frame . . . it is not used in the game.
- 2. Place all the pieces color side down in the middle of all the players.

PLAYING THE GAME

- 1. Each player pops the "POP-O-MATIC", by pressing on the top of the clear plastic dome and releasing. The player with the highest number goes first. The player on his left will go next and so on, around the
- 2. Starting with the first player, each player picks any piece with the number 1 and places it face up in front of him until each player has a different colored Mickey Mouse head.
- 3. Then, each player in turn pops a number, reads it aloud and selects a puzzle piece with that number. If the color of the piece matches the color on his Mickey head, he keeps the piece and places it in front of him. If the color of the pieces doesn't match, he returns the piece to the center but now he puts it color side up.
- 4. A player cannot pick a number he already has. If a player "pops" a number he already has, he then has a free choice of any other number.
- 5. A player can pick either a color side up or a color side down piece.
- 6. The first player who assembles his puzzle in all the same color pieces, WINS!

MORE INVOLVED PLAY FOR OLDER CHILDREN

- 1. Starting with the first player, each player pops a number and picks any part from the playing surface with that number and places it face up in front of him.
- 2. A player may fiot hold two of the same numbered part. If a player pops a number he already has, he then has three options:
 - If he wants the part he has with the matching number, he passes and the next player goes.
 - b) He can exchange the unwanted matching part with another of the same number from the playing surface, returning the unwanted part face down.
 - c) Select the matching part from any other player and return the unwanted part face down to the playing surface, thereby slowing his opponent down.
- 3. The first player to assemble his puzzle in all the same color pieces, WINS!!!
