

**JIG CHASE**

**Directions**

In this exciting jig saw race all players start at the same time, each putting together his own puzzle strip, and the one who does so first wins the game.

At the beginning of the race it is important that all the pieces belonging to each track are separated carefully. Do not tear pieces apart, but bend them back and forth gently until they separate. Each player should receive only the thirty-six pieces belonging to his own track, the designs on the borders identifying the track to which they belong.

To start the game each player shuffles the pieces belonging to the player to his left, forming a loose pile of jig pieces. At the word "GO" each player locates the piece marked "START" from his own pile and places it on the table in front of himself. Then by adding piece to piece the track is extended along until the last piece marked "FINISH" is in place. (Note: After the "START" piece has been placed on the table, players may complete their tracks according to whatever system they may choose.) The first player to completely finish his strip wins the race, but the others continue to race for second and third place.

After each race, players pass their jig pieces to the players to their left, shuffling the pieces in the usual manner. Thus each player will use a different track for each race. One player can race by endeavoring to complete a strip in record time. Twelve minutes is fair, eight minutes excellent and five minutes speedy.
