DIRECTIONS FOR PLAYING THE CROSS WORD PUZZLE GAME AND ANSWERS TO THE PUZZLES

The puzzles in this game were constructed by
Mary E. McCormick and by Richmond C. Snow

The game contains 12 cards with a Cross Word Puzzle on each side. These are diagrams containing black and white squares. The white squares are to be filled with letters arranged in such a manner that they spell words answering the definitions given below each puzzle. Each word should start at the square in which the number appears and extend right or down to the first black square. Every square must be filled. Hence, if there are four spaces to be filled by a word meaning "aid" it is probable that the word is "help".

Go through the puzzle and write all the horizontal words you can, then try the vertical definitions. When all are correctly solved the words will cross each other and all spaces will be filled.

CROSS WORD PUZZLE GAME No. 1

In this game, puzzles 1 to 12 are to be used. Each player takes a puzzle appropriate to his age and at the word "Go" all start to work. The object of the game is to complete the solution quickly and correctly. The players keep at their work until all have finished unless a time limit has been set as mentioned below.

SCORING

The one who finishes first is credited with 300 points.

The one who finishes second is credited with 280 points.

The one who finishes third is credited with 260 points.

The one who finishes fourth is credited with 240 points and so on, each finisher receiving 20 points less than the one who finished immediately before him.

DEDUCTIONS FOR CONSULTING ANSWER BOOK

This answer book may be consulted as often as desired but 10 points have to be deducted for each word secured in this way. The one who desires to find a word from the answer book is not permitted to look for it himself, for he might be tempted to make note of other words. He should say, for instance, to one of the other players or to someone who is not playing, "Please let me know horizontal word No. 16 in puzzle 3." Record of this consultation is to be kept and 10 points for each word so furnished are to be deducted from the total number of points credited the player for finishing.

DEDUCTIONS FOR ERRORS IN ANSWERS

When all players are finished, the answer book is used to prove the accuracy of each solution. Three points are to be deducted for each error. Any words left unsolved count as errors.

THE WINNER

After the deductions for consulting the Answer Book and for errors have been made from the total points secured for finishing quickly as described above under "Scoring", the winner is declared to be the one with the greatest number of points remaining to his credit.

TIME LIMIT

It is well to set a time limit for the game, otherwise one player may hold it up indefinitely. All players who do not finish within the time limit are given 20 points less than the last one to finish.

CROSS WORD PUZZLE GAME No. 2

In this game, puzzles 13 to 18 and puzzles 19 to 24 are used. The first group are all alike and the last group are alike. In this game therefore, as many as six may play, and all the players solve the same puzzle. The answer book cannot be consulted and the one who finishes first wins the game.
