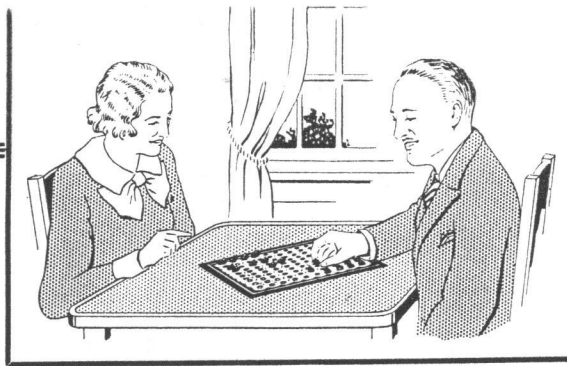

## EASY TO PLAY "CROSS COUNTRY"

The game is played diagonally across the board from corner to corner.

Each player uses ten horses of one color. Each set of horses are placed in opposite corners (diagonally) in the circles marked with the small dots. **THE OBJECT OF THE GAME** is to **WIN** by covering the dots in the opposite corner with your horses first.

A **PLAY** is a single move or one or more consecutive jumps.

A **MOVE** is a play made from one circle to the next.

A **JUMP**—Player may jump both **HIS OWN** and his **OPPONENT'S HORSES**—one at a time—as long as there is an open circle ahead. From two to seven jumps are often possible in one play.

**MOVES** or **JUMPS** may be made to the right or left or to one of the three circles ahead, but **NOT TO THE THREE CIRCLES BEHIND ANY HORSE.**

**HORSES ARE NOT REMOVED FROM THE BOARD WHEN JUMPED.**

Players can use but one horse in a single play or turn and are not permitted to remain in starting corner or stop in any opponent's goal to prevent another player from making final play.

Two players playing with four sets (40 horses) makes an unusual and highly interesting game.

**PROGRESSIVE CROSS COUNTRY** parties of two, three or four tables are becoming quite the thing, wherever this game is known. Three or four players at each table with the 40 horse game. The two winners, 1st and 2nd at each table, move up toward the high table (table #1). When completing all the tables the two high players win the prize. Be the first to introduce this new game in your community parties.
