
WHERE'S WALDO?™

WALDO WATCHER CARD GAME INSTRUCTIONS

An easy to play card game featuring the wild and wacky Waldo.
Look for him. Now you see him, now you don't!

Ages: 5 and up **Players:** 2 to 6

Object of the Game

To be the Champion Waldo Watcher by being first to find him five times.

Equipment

- 72 Waldo Watcher Cards
- 1 Card Tray
- 6 "I Found Waldo!" Cards
- 1 Waldo Watcher Scoring Pad

The Where's Waldo™ Waldo Watcher Card Game "In a Nutshell"

Players watch for Waldo as cards are played face up into the center of the table. Waldo Watchers hurry to be the first to slap down their "I Found Waldo" cards when they spot him. The winner crosses off one of the letters of "WALDO" on the score pad. Cross them all off and you win the game.

Now for the Details

1. **Choosing a Dealer:** Shuffle the deck of cards. Players take turns drawing the top card from the face down deck. **First** player to draw a card showing Waldo is the dealer.
2. **The Waldo Watcher Cards:** The cards are scenes from nine of Waldo's favorite adventures. Each adventure card series includes at least one card showing Waldo.
3. **The "I Found Waldo!" Cards:** Each of the "I Found Waldo!" cards has a different color background. This is so players can see whose card has been slapped down first after Waldo is spotted.

The Scoring Pad

Write each player's name on the scoring pad. Every time a player is first to spot Waldo, the winner crosses off one of the letters of "WALDO," on the line to the right of that player's name.

TO START

Each player gets an "I Found Waldo!" card. All Waldo Watcher cards are dealt **face down** to the players. The cards dealt to each player are stacked up face down to form that player's DRAW pile. **DON'T LOOK AT YOUR CARDS...**the surprise is part of the fun!

TO PLAY

Players, each in turn from the left of the dealer, take the top card from their **DRAW** pile without looking at it and turn it **FACE UP** in the center of the table.

DO NOT TRY TO MAKE A PILE when turning cards face up. The **SCENES SHOULD SHOW** so that no part of **any** card is covered. When Waldo is spotted on **any** of the cards, the first player to slap down his/her "I Found Waldo!" card wins the round and crosses off one of the letters of "**WALDO**" to the right of that player's name. If more than one "I Found Waldo!" has been slapped down, the card on the **bottom** always wins the round.

A player who incorrectly identifies Waldo must sit out one round as a penalty.

The cards played are now placed face up in the discard pile in the card tray. Everybody picks up their "I Found Waldo!" card. The player to the left of the person who won that round starts the next round. Players continue in this way until a player wins by crossing off all the "**WALDO**" letters on their line on the scoring pad.

If there is no winner when all the cards have been played, reshuffle the discard pile and deal out the cards to continue play.
