J. Pressman & Co., N.Y.C. No. 6770. It measures $12 \frac{1}{8} \times 12 \frac{1}{8} \times 1 \frac{3}{4}$. The bottom of the box is made of wood. The lid is cardboard, with the instructions on the inside. There are 4 small red bowling pins, 4 small green ones, and a wind-up top. The instructions are as follows:

Instructions

The pins are set down on the spots. The top is wound as tight as possible, and must land on the center spot of the board when it is spun. The inside pins count five points each and the corner pins count ten points each. The player first scoring 300 points wins the game.
