#### OPERATION

"Quizzical Questions" is ready for operation when packed.

There are thirty-two questions to a disc, sixteen on each side, and are selected by turning the center dial arrow opposite the question mark on the hat. The question is revealed by opening the question slide. The answer is found under the slide window marked "Answer".

Each disc of questions is marked showing the kind of questions on the disc and the discs may be changed as desired by lifting the hinged platform.

#### PLAY

To produce the greatest enjoyment, follow as closely as possible the system used by "Professor Quiz" in his radio program. Appoint one person to act as the Professor who will turn the dial to question number one for the first contestant, number two for the second, etc. Credits of 100 points are allowed each person correctly answering the question and on the clear thinkers 200 point are allowed. In cases where a question is partially answered the professor will be the judge as to the number of points credit to be given. Decision must be made before play, by the players, as to what group of questions and the number of each that are to be used.

It is suggested that not over two questions on a subject be given any one person, as a diversified group of subjects makes the play more interesting to all players.

After completing the group selected, finish with one clear thinking question for each person.

The person having the largest score is the winner.
