

INSTRUCTIONS

Place all the cards face down in the middle of the table.

The first player chooses a card, being careful that the other players do not see it. If the card he drew is the BOTTOM HALF of a picture, he lays the card in front of him face up. If the card he chose is the TOP HALF, he returns it to the center of the table, face down.

If the card he draws matches a BOTTOM HALF which he already has, he keeps the picture in front of him.

If he draws a TOP HALF which matches the BOTTOM HALF being held by another player, he may take the BOTTOM HALF from the other player and make a completed picture for himself.

Each player follows in turn. A player draws but once each turn.

The WINNER is the one having the most pictures when all the cards have been played.
