DIRECTIONS

Each player is given four cards face downward, the balance of the cards being placed on the table face downward.

The one who distributes the cards then selects any question from one of his cards, and reads it to the player at his right. The same question is repeated to each player in turn, until correct name is answered. If name is not guessed another question on the same card is read, and each player is asked in turn, until all four questions are asked, or a correct answer received. The one giving the correct answer receives the card, which is laid aside. The one giving the card replaces it by taking one from the pack on the table. The next player at the right, then asks questions from one of his cards and this is repeated until all cards are exhausted. Each player at the end of the game adds the points marked on the cards they have won, and the one receiving the most points is the winner.

If a correct answer is not received to any of the four questions on a card, the questioner adds the card to the others he has won. The references should be read from the Bible however, so that the players will become familiar with the subject.

Any of the players receiving the Star Card, or drawing it from the table pack is entitled to ten points and lays the card aside, taking another from the table pack to replace it. Players should always have four cards, unless there are no more on the table to take from.

A large number may play this game. Sides are chosen by two captains, alternatively, the same as for a spelling bee. The teacher then asks questions from a card, questioning a player on one captain's side, and then on the other captain's side, until cards are exhausted. The side which receives most total points, and the individual player receiving most points is champion.
