

DIRECTIONS FOR PLAYING MARKS BROTHERS CO. HORSE-RACING GAME

Several kinds of races may be played with this game.

1. Regular Race.

Place each horse on the track of the corresponding color. Throw three dice and whatever numbers show on the dice, these horses on their respective tracks move one space. If two dice show the same number, that horse moves up two spaces, and if three dice show the same number, that horse moves up three spaces. In order for a horse to win, it is necessary that a double be thrown after the horse is in the space next to the finish.

2. Slow Race.

The same rules apply to this race as for the regular race, except that the last horse to come in wins.

3. Hurdle Race.

The same rules apply as for the regular race, except when any of the horses come to the hurdle, it is necessary to throw a double before the horse can jump the hurdle.

Players may make up their own races and any changes in rules they care to make.
