Directions for Playing

SIX VARIATIONS OF "STAK"

NO. 1 — FOR ONE PLAYER

Scatter sticks on the table and see how many you can stack up without making the pile topple over.

NO. 2 - FOR TWO OR MORE PLAYERS

Gather up all the sticks in one or two hands and toss sufficiently to scatter them on the table. Start picking up the sticks one at a time without moving any underneath or any nearby and stack each stick so obtained on top of the cone. The player continues this until one of the sticks so picked up moves another one or until the pile topples over. The number of sticks so piled are scored as follows:

RED STICK — 5 POINTS
YELLOW STICK—10 POINTS
BLUE STICK — 3 POINTS
GREEN STICK — 2 POINTS

NO. 3 - FOR TWO OR MORE PLAYERS

The sticks are divided equally among all the players regardless of color. Each player in turn places one stick on top of the cone. When a player by stacking his sticks causes the rest of them to fall off, he must take all that have been thrown down. The purpose of this game is for the player to dispose of his sticks. The one doing so first wins the game.

NO. 4 - FOR ONE OR MORE PLAYERS

Scatter the sticks on the table. The players take turns stacking up as many sticks as they possibly can and the one stacking the largest number wins.

NO. 5 - FOR TWO OR MORE PLAYERS

Scatter the sticks on the table. Start off by placing two sticks on top of the cone, four sticks on top of the two sticks, six sticks on top of the four sticks, etc., in multiples of two. The player who is able to stack the largest number of sticks in his top layer, wins the game.

NO. 6 - FOR TWO OR MORE PLAYERS

Give to each player an equal number of sticks of each color. The players take turns by adding one stick at a time. The idea of this game is to dispose of the sticks having the highest pay value. The person who runs out of sticks first is the winner of the game and is paid by the other players according to the value of the sticks they have left and not according to the *number* of sticks left. The sticks have the following values:

GREEN — 2 POINTS
BLUE — 3 POINTS
RED — 5 POINTS
YELLOW — 10 POINTS
