

CONVERSATION CARDS.

DIRECTIONS.—Shuffle the cards and when dealt, deal equally. When but two play, several methods prevail. By one, the first player asks all the questions, and the second answers them; then a new deal takes place, and the second player becomes the questioner.

By another, the first player asks a question; the second answers and then asks a question; the first answers, and then asks a second question, and so on.

The cards dealt are sometimes laid in a pile, and the question and answers used in the order of the cards, beginning at the top; or if so agreed, each player may select his question and answer from the cards held by him. Sometimes players draw a card in turn from the packs using the question and answer upon it.

When more than two play, the first player asks the second a question; the second answers and asks a question of the third, the third answers and asks a question of the fourth, and so on. When many play a questioner is sometimes appointed, who puts questions here and there at random. A good questioner can create a good deal of fun.
