

DIRECTIONS FOR PLAYING

THE GAME OF

GUESS AGAIN

ANY NUMBER CAN PLAY

GUESS AGAIN is played with a pack of thirty-six cards. Each card has upon it two numbers, separated by a hyphen.

Shuffle the cards thoroughly all together, and deal one card at a time, face down, until all are dealt. Each player must have an equal number of cards, if there are any extra cards they must be laid aside.

The dealer begins the game by taking a card from the hand and placing it *face down* on the table, taking care to remember the numbers on the card. When the card is ready the dealer says "*Guess*" and the player on his left must try to guess the first (or left-hand) number on the card. If he guesses the number correctly, the dealer says "*All right, guess again,*" and the other player must try to guess

the second (or right-hand) number on the card. If he guesses both numbers correctly, the card is laid aside, and in addition to this he may take one card from his hand and lay it aside with the other.

If however the player should not guess the first number correctly, the dealer would say "*Wrong, guess again,*" and the player would then guess at the second number on the card. If he guesses but one number correctly, then the card on the table is laid aside, and that card only. If he does not guess either number correctly, then he must take up the card and keep it in his hand.

Whether the player makes a correct guess or not, it then becomes his turn to place a card from his hand, face down on the table, and the player on *his* left must guess in like manner.

The object of the game is to get rid of the cards in one's hand, the player who first succeeds, *wins the game.*

The *first guess* is always for the first number on the cards, and the *second guess* is always for the second number on the card.
