Directions:

Select a dealer to conduct the game. After each call of Lotto, this position passes to the player on the left of the last dealer.

The dealer allows each player to select three cards, which they lay on the table in front of them, with their surfaces exposed.

After shaking well together ^{ER} the numbered pieces in the box, the dealer begins the game by taking them out one by one, without looking into the box, calling out the number of each as drawn, and placing it on the table in sight of all the players.

The players note the number of each piece drawn, and called by the dealer, and immediately cover the corresponding number wherever it can be found upon their cards.

The player who first succeeds in covering all the numbered spaces of one row, upon either of his cards, call Lotto, and wins.

This well known game can be played by any method the players may select.
