

BATMAN

Jigsaw Puzzle Game for 2, 3, or 4 playersSM

THE OBJECT OF THE GAME is to be the first player to assemble a complete Batman puzzle.

TO SET UP THE GAME

1. Remove the outside cover. Carefully push out the circle in the inside cover. Separate the two "Bat" puzzle pieces from this circle, and add them to the loose pieces already in the box. The round hole is the opening used for reaching into the box to pick pieces during the game. Shake the box occasionally to mix them up.

2. At the beginning of the game, each player draws five (5) pieces from the box, one at a time, WITHOUT LOOKING. (If a player picks a BAT piece he must put it back and take another.)

3. Players assemble as much of the puzzle as possible with their 5 pieces.

NOTE: The pieces make four (7x10-inch) identical picture puzzles of BATMAN, 20 pieces for each puzzle.

RULES

1. Players take turns, going clockwise.

2. In a turn, a player, WITHOUT LOOKING, reaches in and takes ONE puzzle piece from the box. He reads the instructions on the BACK of this piece and MUST DO what it says, as follows:

- a. "Use this piece" — player keeps it.
- b. "Lose 1 piece" — player puts back ANY 1 of his pieces.
- c. "Lose 2 pieces" — player puts back ANY 2 of his pieces.
- d. "Pick one more piece" — player keeps this piece, picks one extra from the box, keeps it, and his turn ends.
- e. "Pick 2 more pieces" — player keeps the first one and picks 2 extra from the box, keeps them, and his turn ends.
- f. If an EXTRA piece is a "Bat" piece, the player returns it to the box and draws another.

3. When a player picks a BAT piece, he takes ONE piece of his choice from any OPPONENT. He then RETURNS the BAT piece to the box and SHAKES it before the next player's turn.

4. Players may collect more than one of the same puzzle piece. The extras (duplicates) are kept by the player and may be used for putting back if a "LOSE" piece is picked as in rule 2, b and c.

5. A player may SHAKE the box (with or without the cover) if he wishes, either before his turn or after picking a piece.

6. If the box contains ONLY the two BAT pieces, and no one has completed a puzzle, the extra (duplicate) pieces held by all the players are put back, the box shaken and the game continued.

7. The first player to complete a puzzle is the WINNER.

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
