The object of the game is to capture one of the different groups of the families and the player who first succeeds in so doing by the following rules wins the game.

Directions

1. Shuffle the cards and distribute them equally among the players.
2. Any player, as agreed, can commence the game by calling on any player, for any card he has not in his own hand as follows: Dr. Busby, Mother Busby, Jack Busby, or Cinderella Busby.
3. If the player asked has the card wanted, he hands it to the one who asked for it. The player must at once say, "Thank you." The player who fails to do this loses the play and must at once return the card to the player he has drawn it from.
4. The player who first succeeds in getting four cards of one family together wins the game.
