FAIRY TALES

This game comprises nine pairs of cards and one odd card.

The object is not to be left with the card, Mother Gross, at the end of the Game.

The two cards, of a pair have pictures alike.

The odd card represents Mother Goose.

Deal all the cards with faces down, one at a time.

The player on the left of the dealer draws a card from his right hand neighbor, and then, if possible matches one or more pairs, which he plays face up on the table.

When the player has made all the matches possible, or if he cannot make any, the next player to the left plays in the same manner, and thus the game proceeds till all the pairs are matched, and the player then holding the odd card of Mother Goose LOSES THE GAME.
