

# MIMIC RING-TOSS

PLACE the post in the hole of the block in the bottom of the box. Each player in turn takes the rings, holds his hand two feet from the post and tries to throw as many rings as possible over the post. The rings that encircle the post count 1 each, for the large size, 2 for the medium, and 5 for the small ones. The total score is made up after three rounds have been played. The winner is the one scoring the greatest number.
