

GAME OF
Old Maid

DIRECTIONS

This game comprises nineteen pairs of cards and one odd card.
The two cards of a pair are numbered alike.

The odd card represents the "Old Maid."

Any number of players from three to six may join in the game.

Deal all the cards with faces down one at a time.

The player on the left of the dealer draws a card from his right hand neighbor and then if possible matches one or more pairs, which he plays, faces up, to the center of the table.

When this player has made all the matches possible, or if he can not make any the next player to the left plays in the same manner, and thus the game proceeds till all the pairs are matched and the player then holding the odd card is declared to be the "Old Maid."



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
