OF THE

UNITED STATES.

THIS is not simply a dissected Map, but is constructed on a principle entirely new, and invented by a lady well known in literary circles and celebrated for her interest in the improvement of the young.

While the Map is cut into several rectangular pieces for convenience in packing and handling, as well as for the amusement in putting together, still, that is no part of the invention for which we claim the superiority of this over other dissected Maps. It will be seen that all of the small circular pieces—each of which bears a name of some State, City, Lake, &c.—are of a uniform size and are interchangeable, the one for the other; consequently, while in an ordinary dissected Map, the child, or other person, is guided by the form of the piece, as well as by the design printed thereon, in this the form is no guide, and in order to properly put the Map together, he must learn the names and localities of the several States, Capitals, Oceans, &c.

It will also be seen by referring to the Map that over each circular hole there is a number. The following Key, numbered accordingly, will form a perfect guide by which to test the correctness of the child's efforts.

The small circular piece should be inserted on the top of the Map, and then when taken out should be forced down THROUGH, rather than to push it back out at the same side on which it was inserted. The observance of this will save much trouble, as well as great wear to the Map.
