DIRECTIONS

Cut the enclosed sheet in two pieces. Then cut out the hats on the outline. Pin the figure of Uncle Wiggily on the wall. Blindfold each player. Give each one a hat. Stand the player a few feet from the figure of Uncle Wiggily. Turn the player around twice, leaving him facing the figure. It will then be the object of the player to pin the hat on Uncle Wiggily. The player getting the hat nearest the correct position on Uncle Wiggily's head, between the ears, is declared the winner.

This game is a very attractive one for children's parties and creates much amusement even when played by the grown-ups. There is a distinct educational value in this game, as each hat represents some nationality. A prize may be given to the winner, which adds much interest to the game.

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
