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# **RAINBOW GAME**

*For Two, Three or Four Players*

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## **DIRECTIONS FOR PLAYING**

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**OBJECTIVE:** To reach the center of the spiral first.

**ORDER OF PLAY:** Red man plays first; yellow, second, blue third; and green, fourth.

**PLAYING RULES:** The men are entered on space marked "In." The first player takes one of the colored cubes and places it in a cup. He shakes the cup and then allows the cube to roll out onto the board or table. He then moves his man along the spiral pathway on the board to the colored space corresponding to the color which is uppermost on the cube. That is, if purple is on the top side of cube, the player moves his man to the purple space. The next player proceeds in the same way. The play continues in this way, the player moving along to the color thrown each time until he reaches the purple in the center of the board.

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If a player lands on a colored space corresponding to the color of his man, he has an extra turn.

When a player gets near the final end of the trip and is unable to throw a purple to bring him into the last space, he must go backward to the color thrown. That is, he must move every turn, and if he cannot go forward he must go backward.

The first player to reach the center purple space is the winner.

**A VARIATION OF THE GAME FOR TWO PLAYERS:** The game proceeds as in the preceding directions, but if two players land on the same color, they must both go back to "In" and start over again.

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
