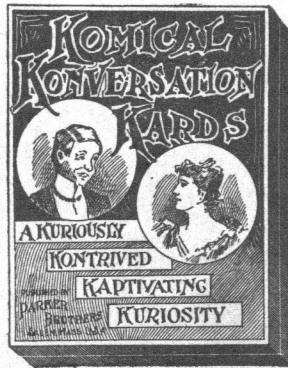

The Question cards are printed upon one color, the Answers upon another.

Separate the Questions from the Answers; divide them evenly among the players, or let some players have all the Answers and others the Questions. Players keep cards face down until used, and draw at random. On drawing a Question card a player reads it, and looks at one of the company for an answer. He at once draws a card from the pack of Answers and reads it.

Much amusement is caused by the comical character of the Questions and Answers.
