

"TRADE"

A new game manufactured by
ARTRAY, Montclair, N. J.

This box contains 4 puzzles of 16 pieces each.

Deal face down as in cards, 16 pieces to each of four players. Each player turns up picture side and assembles as many pieces as possible, the object being to complete the picture of which the player has the most pieces.

Player to left of dealer looks over all pieces, selects one from any other player and *trades* one of his. The next player to the left and the others in turn do the same. The player completing his picture first wins the hand.

SCORE is follows: each player, other than the winner, counts the number of pieces put together in his own puzzle and scores that number. The winner scores 25 points. The game score is 50 points.

After completing a hand, take puzzles apart and shuffle well before dealing

PENALTY—Any player found having more than 16 pieces forfeits a turn for each excess piece and allows players having less than 16 to draw from him.

"TRADE" gives an excellent training in the judgment of form and color.
