Instructions for Playing the GAME OF WILD FLOWERS.

We have arranged the fifty-two cards into twelve families, not scientific families, but nearer by color relations. The first family has eight members in it, and if you are successful in completing this it will count you twenty-five towards the game. The other families count from five to twenty, and each are marked. The one obtaining the highest total count after all of the sets are completed wins the game.

Rules:—Any number over three may play. Place the pack of cards face down on the table, and each player draw out one card. The one having the lowest number on the upper left hand corner will be the dealer to start the game.

Shuffle the cards well and

beginning at your left give each player one card, and continue dealing in that way until all of the cards are given out. The one holding No. 1-A "swamp rose" will start the game by calling for Common Pink Flowers, and any card which you do not have in that group. If you succeed in getting the one called for you continue until you fail, when the player at your left calls from any of the color families in the same manner until all of the families are complete. The one securing the highest count wins the game. It makes the game much more interesting and educational to ask questions of the one who calls for the card, as to where the plant grows, whether in a swamp, open field or in the deep woods.
