

DIRECTIONS

The "PLAY BALL" baseball game may be played by any number of players; either individually or in teams. Regular baseball rules are used; for example, three outs retires the side and the most runs at the end of a regulation 9 inning game decides the winner.

The "ball" is placed in the small hole on Home Plate. Then, the bat is brought forward by snapping it with the finger sharply, thus driving the ball out into the playing field. When the ball enters a hole, the play is scored according to the instructions at each hole.

If the ball fails to enter the hole, the play is considered a strike. Three consecutive strikes make an out.
