

ADDITIONAL RULES:

- * If more than one batter is on base, then the batter may divide his/her roll amongst all the runners or use the entire roll on one runner.
- * If a runner reaches a base before the ball he/she has the option to continue on to the next base or call it safe and a new play begins.
- * Once a runner leaves a base he/she must go on to the next base.
- * No 2 runners can be on a base at the same time.
- * Once a fielder has reached the ball then he/she may use the remainder of the roll (if any) for the advancement of the ball to the designated base.
- * A fielder must also meet the ball on the base to which the ball has been thrown.
- * Once the ball has begun its approach towards a base, it must reach that base before any other throw can be attempted.
- * If a fly ball is hit and is placed within 2 squares of a fielder then the fly ball is assumed caught and the batter is automatically out.
- * If the added coordinates exceed the 33 mark on the red or blue panels or falls in the area marked "BIG TIME BASEBALL" then the hit is automatically a HOMERUN!

BIG TIME[®] BASEBALL

CONTENTS:

- (1) 19½ X 19½ GAMEBOARD
- (1) SCORE PAD
- (9) FIELDERS (RED)
- (4) BATTERS (BLUE)
- (6) 12-SIDED PLACING DICE
(3 red & 3 blue)
- (1) PITCHING DIE (WHITE)
- (1) HITTING DIE (BLACK)
- (1) BASEBALL

SET UP:

- * Basic Rules of Baseball apply.
- * Choose Your Team:
 - HOME TEAM = PITCHING TEAM (RED)
 - VISITING TEAM = BATTING TEAM (BLUE)
- * Pitching team must place one fielder on the pitching mound and one fielder as catcher behind homeplate.
- * One fielder must be set in any square near each base marked 1, 2, & 3.
- * One fielder must be placed in any square within two squares of the baseline between 2nd & 3rd base.
- * Three fielders must be placed in any square in the outfield. (Your choice of location in left, center, and right fields)
- * The batting team must place a batter at homeplate.
- * The ball should also be placed on homeplate next to the batter.

PITCHING DIE RULES:

- * The pitching die is used to determine the type of pitch rolled.

WHITE PITCHING DIE:

- 3 (S) Strikes - "You're Out!"
- 4 (B) Balls - Go to first base.
- 1 (H) Hit - Roll the black hitting die.

HITTING DIE RULES:

- * The hitting die is used to determine the type of hit rolled.

BLACK HITTING DIE:

- F = (FLY) Allows you to use all 6 placing dice (Your choice but at least 1 red and 1 blue must be used)
- G = (GROUNDER) Allows you to use a combination of 4 placing dice (Again your choice but at least 1 red & 1 blue)
- B = (BUNT) 2 placing dice (1 red & 1 blue)

TO BEGIN PLAY:

- * The batting team begins the game by rolling the white pitching die.
- * Every time a Ball (B) is rolled, pitching die rules apply.
- * Every time a Strike (S) is rolled, pitching die rules apply.
- * Once a Hit (H) is rolled, the batting team rolls the black hitting die to determine the type of hit.
- * Once the type of hit has been determined, then the batting team must roll the number of placing dice chosen according to the type of hit rolled. (SEE HITTING DIE RULES)

- * The batting team then adds all the red dice together to get the red coordinate. Do the same with the blue dice to get the blue coordinate.
- * Using the red & blue coordinates move inward from the numbered panels - Place the Ball! (SEE Fig. A)

EXAMPLE:

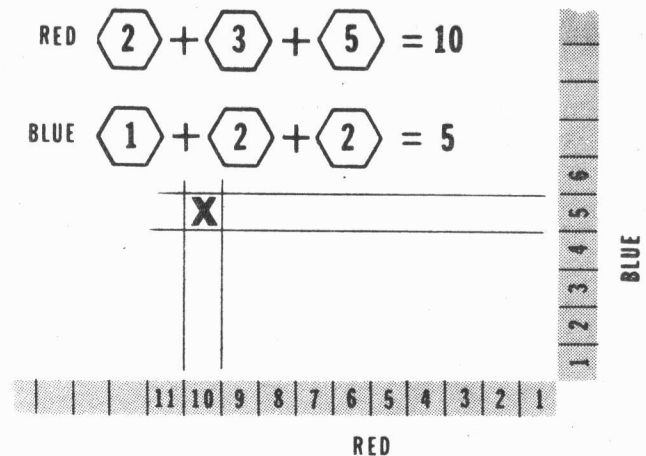

PLAY BALL!

- * The batter and fielder now begin to take turns rolling the dice - starting with the batter.
- * The batter rolls (1) blue placing die to determine the number of squares advanced towards 1st base.
- * The fielder rolls (1) red placing die to determine the number of squares advanced towards the placed ball. This advancement can be in any direction.
- * The batter and fielder continue rotating turns until the play has been completed; 3 outs and the fielders come to bat.
- * Play continues through 9 innings. High score wins. In case of tie, play extra innings.
