

THE GAME OF LOTTO

Any number of persons can take part in this game as long as there are sufficient cards. A dealer is selected, who equally distributes the cards, which each player lays in front of him face up. All the cards need not be distributed, the players can agree to take one or more cards each, just as they like, but no player must have a larger or smaller number of cards than the others. The dealer then puts the pieces, which are numbered from 1 to 90, into a box or a bag, shakes them and takes out one after the other, without looking into the box or bag, calling out the numbers as he takes them out. The player, who finds the number, called out on his cards, must cover it with a counter, and the one, who has first covered all the numbers on his cards, is the winner.

After a game is finished, ~~The~~ the player on the left of the dealer is dealer next.
