

# Directions for Authors



Shuffle the cards and deal them, one at a time, until the pack runs out. The players must arrange their cards according to the letter thereon. Four cards of the same letters form a book ; all complete books are placed on the table in front of their owner, face down. The player on the left of the dealer must then call on any other player for any card that he needs to complete a book ; if he calls a card that the player holds, it must be given up to him, whereupon he continues to call on him or any other player, until he fails to get a card, when the turn passes to the one last called on. When all the cards are made into books, the player having the most, is declared the winner.
