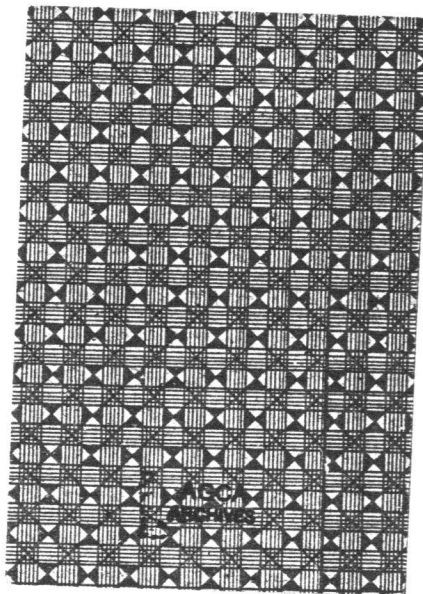

HAPPY FAMILIES

A jolly game for any number of players. The cards are shuffled and dealt round to all the players. The object of the game is to acquire as many complete families as possible. A family consists of four characters of the same name i.e. Mr. Chip, Mrs. Chip, Miss Chip and Master Chip.

The game commences by the player on the left of the dealer asking one of the others for a character he requires to complete or partly complete a family. If this player has the card he must surrender it and the first player may continue to ask any of the players for cards he requires until refused. The one who refuses him says "NOT AT HOME" and he in turn may ask in the same way for any cards he requires.

No player may ask for a card of any family unless he holds at least one card of that same family.

When a family is complete, it is placed face downwards on the table in front of the player. The game is finished when all the families are complete, the player holding the greatest number of families being the winner.
